At a General Meeting of the above Club held at the Illingworth Church Institute on Friday evening February 22nd 1884 the following rules were drawn up for the Club

- (1) That this club be called the St Mary's Cricket Club
- (2) That the Club be conducted by a President (the Vicar of Illingworth) a Vice-President Treasurer Secretary and a Committee of six to be elected at the general meeting of the Club held on the first Monday in October in each year

no person be admitted as a

member of this Club unless he be a Teacher or Scholar in St Mary's Sunday School or a member of the Congregation of that Church

- (3) That the Entrance Fee be one shilling and the subscription five shillings per annum or six pence per month from the first of April to the 30th of September and four pence per month from the 1st of October to the 31st of March, to be paid in advance at the monthly meeting of the Committee

- (5) Annual subscribers shall be excused an entrance fee, and all the Annual subscriptions shall become due on the 1st of May in each year

- (6) Any member omitting to pay his subscription for three months after it is due, having received notice from the Secretary to do so, shall be considered a defaulter and treated accordingly

- (7) That the officials meet once a month on the first Monday to receive subscriptions and consider other matters, three to form a quorum

- (8) That no member be allowed to smoke or lie down when he is engaged on the field
- (9) That any member conducting himself improperly, either by word or deed be fined 6d and if he refuses to pay the fine or persist in such conduct he shall be dealt with as the Committee shall think fit

- (10) That no challenge be given or accepted but through the Secretary and all matches to be decided on by the Committee by whom the teams shall also be selected.

- (11) That the Secretary acquaint those who shall have been fixed on to play in a match at least three whole days before such match and any member absenting himself without a satisfactory reason and notifying the same to the Secretary at least one whole day before the day of the match shall be dealt with as the Committee think fit. A member leaving the field before the conclusion of a game without the captain's consent be fined 6d.

- (12) That any member wilfully injuring the property of the Club be fined or otherwise dealt with by the Committee
