

A Huge Score

At a later stage in the club's history Linthwaite had lost one wicket for three runs against Golcar, at Linthwaite, but George Fletcher and George Knight carried the total to 234 for two. In a League deciding game against Kirkburton, at Paddock, in 1920, Linthwaite scored 495. George Knight (104) and H. Iredale (58) put on over 100 for the first wicket, and Joe Jebson (77) and the late "Jimmy" Pearson (66) added 140 for the last wicket. In the same match G. Fletcher scored 92. Kirkburton had previously beaten Broad Oak at Armitage Bridge.

Once in a Lumb Cup-tie at Linthwaite the visitors, Linthwaite Hall, made what was considered in those days to be an excellent total of 185, and had dismissed four of the home team for 38. The brothers Willie and John Shaw then took the score to 142 for the next wicket, and Linthwaite won the match. On another occasion Kirkburton visited Linthwaite, and set the home team 97 runs to make in forty minutes. "Bill" Ellis and John Shaw actually knocked off the runs in twenty-six minutes!
