

Stainland are Division Two champions, 20 years after they last won this division. They were relegated the following season and have spent 19 years in Division Two.

They completed their revival and run-in to the title with an eight-wicket win at Old Crossleyans, who were out for 97 in 46 overs, Ian Ord taking seven for 36.

In reply, the champions made 101 for two, Graham Young scoring 45 and Barry Goldsborough 30 not out.

They were presented with the shield after the match by league chairman Terry Wynne.

Joining them in Division One next year will be runners-up Mytholmroyd, whose late burst into top form was completed with a nine-wicket victory at Outlane, who were dismissed for 133.
