

TINKER CUP

Clayton West Win by 21 Runs

Clayton West won the Tinker Cup by beating Skelmanthorpe at Shelley on Saturday by 21 runs.

Clayton West won the toss to take first innings before a moderately good crowd. The opening over from B. Kenworthy produced two wickets, and after this more men were dismissed cheaply. A useful stand by Exley and Ormondroyd pulled the game round, however, and the innings realised 76. The Skelmanthorpe bowlers returned the following figures: Kenworthy five for 42, Appleyard one for 14, and Smith three for 13.

Skelmanthorpe began badly, for Poulter bowled White in his first over, and Smith in his second. Keeping a fine length, and bowling at a good pace, Poulter, who was backed up by splendid fielding, tied Skelmanthorpe down, and they were eventually out for 55. Poulter took eight of the wickets for 22 runs.
