

RULES of the Lascelles Hall Cricket Club.

1.—The Club shall be called "THE LASCELLES HALL CRICKET CLUB," and its objects shall be the promotion and encouragement of the game of Cricket and the social enjoyment of its members.

2.—Every new member shall be elected by the Committee. Any member may propose a candidate, and the name of such candidate, his address and the signature of the member proposing him, must be entered in a proposal book, kept in the Pavilion for that purpose. Every entry in the proposal book shall be considered by the Committee at the meeting immediately following each such entry. The Committee shall have power to refuse to elect any candidate to membership, and their decision shall be final.

3.—The Secretary shall notify a candidate of his election and at the same time furnish him with a member's card and a copy of the rules. The Committee shall have power to elect from time to time, honorary members, without entrance fee or subscription, after giving not less than three days' notice to the members of their intention. Such honorary members shall enjoy the full privileges of the Club. Members of visiting teams shall become honorary members for the day on which the match is in progress without entrance fee or subscription, after being elected by the Committee, who shall give two clear days' notice to the members of their intention to make such honorary members, and shall enjoy the full privileges of the Club.

4.—The annual Subscription shall be as follows :—
Honorary Members, 3/6 ; Playing Members, 6/6 ; and
Youths, under 18, 4/- ; under 16, 2/6.

5.—Any member not returning his card before May 1st will be considered still a member, and will be liable for that year's subscription. On return of card the member will be considered to have resigned. Any member being in arrears on June 8th, shall have his attention drawn to the fact by the Secretary, either by circular or otherwise, and if the same be not paid by the last day of June, his name shall be posted in the pavilion. Any member ceasing to be a member shall forfeit all right to, or claim upon the Club.

Election of Committee.

6.—The Committee shall consist of 13 members, who shall elect one of their own number as Chairman, and the Captains of the first and second teams shall be ex-officio members of the Committee.

Power of Committee.

7. The Committee shall have power to deal with all matters, and make and enforce bye-laws for the efficient management of the Club.

Meetings of Committee.

8.—The Committee shall meet every Tuesday at 7-30 p.m., all other meetings to be called by the Secretary.

9.—The Officers and Committee shall be elected annually at a General Meeting, and in case of a vacancy in their body they shall have power to appoint any other member to office. A report by the Secretary and the Treasurer's Accounts shall be presented to the meeting. Two Auditors shall also be appointed at that meeting to audit the accounts of the Club.

10.—Refreshments are provided in the pavilion at stated prices, and members are requested to pay that price to the member in charge of the bar. Strangers are not allowed to purchase intoxicating liquors in any case whatever.

11.—A member shall be permitted to introduce one or more friends as visitors, but the same visitor shall not be introduced by the same or any other member more than six times in one year, unless the special consent of the Committee be obtained.

No member is allowed to introduce a visitor on a Sunday who lives within a radius of one mile of the Club's premises.

The name of each visitor shall be entered in the Visitors' Book, and countersigned by the member introducing him, and such member shall be responsible for the conduct and liability of such visitor or visitors.

No visitor shall be supplied with any excisable article except the same be ordered and paid for by a member of the Club.

No person who has been expelled, or who, having been a candidate for election has been rejected, or who, being indebted to the Club (see Rule 7), has ceased to be a member, shall be allowed to make use of the Club.

12.—The proceeds of the sale of refreshments shall be carried forward to the credit of the Club funds, and to promote the objects of the Club.

13.—The ground and pavilion of the Club shall be open at such times and during such hours as the Committee may from time to time determine. The bar shall be kept open from 11-30 a.m. to 12, and 2 p.m. to 9-30 p.m. on Week-days ; Sundays, 12 p.m. to 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 10 p.m.

14.—Gambling, drunkenness, obscene language or disorderly conduct, is strictly prohibited, and any offending member shall be liable to a fine or expulsion.

Damaging Club Property.

15.—Any member damaging club property, shall make good the same, and be liable to a fine or expulsion.

16.—These rules shall be printed, and a copy supplied to each member, and a copy shall be hung in the Club Rooms.

17.—No rule shall be altered, except at the Annual or Special General Meeting called for that purpose. Notice of alteration to be sent to the Secretary, seven clear days before such meeting.
