

Stones out for 92.

WARLEY VICTORY IN PARISH CUP FINAL

ALTHOUGH play in the resumed Parish Cup Final did not start until 7.20 p.m. last night, because of the damp state of the wicket, it only took Warley an hour to bowl 13.4 overs and dismiss the remaining six Stones batsmen for a combined total of 92. Dan Hamer contributed 16 before he was bowled by Roy Crossley, and his partnership with R. Pollard put on 31 for the fifth wicket—the highest partnership of the Stones innings.

The addition of only ten runs saw Stones lose a further four wickets and at 69 for nine it looked all over "bar the shout." A last-wicket partnership of 23 between Phillip Parry and John Kenworthy, however, made the Stones score look better. Both Roy Crossley and Alex South bowled unchanged as they did the previous night, the latter having the better return with six wickets for 47 runs.

The Mayor of Halifax, Coun. Tom Barry, J.P., introduced by the Parish Cup secretary, Mr. J. Crossley, presented the trophy to Warley's captain, Roy Crossley.

On Monday evening, when the match began after Saturday's "wash-out," Warley batted the limit of 40 overs for their total of 188 for five.
