

# Andy Day – Westborough CC

## (Bench Memorial)



In addition to Westborough, all-rounder Andy Day played for Dewsbury, Thornhill, Hopton Mills and Slazengers. But the team he loved most was Westborough of the Huddersfield Central League. His greatest moment with the club came in the Section 'B' title-winning 2002 season when he won the divisional batting prize.

Tragically, Andy died the following year after an eight-month battle with skin cancer. Club secretary Barry Mitchell paid tribute to Andy by saying that he was an 'excellent team man and, although he played for other teams, he came back to Westborough because he loved it best. He will be greatly missed by everyone.'

A special seat at Westborough's new ground at The Combs, Thornhill, is dedicated to Andy's memory.
