## INTRODUCTION

The Heavy Woollen District Challenge Cup Committee held its first meeting at the Royal Hotel in Batley on October 18<sup>th</sup> 1882 and made a draw from twenty five local teams.

The Cup was open to all clubs situated within six miles of Batley Town Hall and until 1890 had no professional players. The object of the competition was to develop local talent.

The original trophy was commissioned in 1882 at a cost of £49.5sh standing two feet high and weighing seventy two troy ounces
