## INTRODUCTION

Before Upper Hopton Cricket Club was formed in 1904, cricket was played at Upper Hopton Working Men's Club which had a Cricket & Football Club section. Upper Hopton Cricket Clubs headquarters were at the Travellers Rest Inn with the first recorded meeting being held on 24 June 1904. Mr S Vickers was appointed secretary and nine committee men were elected. At a further meeting held on July 5th, about seventy people had agreed to become members and subscriptions were fixed at two shillings per year and on 25 August Mr Marriott was approached to become the first president

Today, Upper Hopton Cricket Club is a member of the Arrow Huddersfield Central Cricket League and operates purely as an amateur club. Its present ground is known as The Sutcliffe Memorial Ground and was donated to the village of Upper Hopton in 1923 by Charles E Sutcliffe.
