INTRODUCTION

The Club was re-formed in 1959 by some members of Bradley and Colnebridge Working Mens Club, though there had been a cricket field in Colnebridge since 1843. In 1893 Colnebridge Cricket Club became founder members of the Huddersfield District Alliance League. Bradley and Colnebridge Cricket Club joined the Huddersfield & District Association League in 1923 but left and disbanded in 1930. When the Club was re-formed it entered Huddersfield Cricket Association with teams in Sections B & C. They won their first trophy in 1965 when the 1st team took the Section B Championship. The Club left the Association in 1975 and joined the Huddersfield Central League. In 1994 they left the Colnebridge ground for one at Warrenside where they remain today (2006)
