## Newcomers make winning start



League newcomers Mount CC recorded an overwhelming 120 run victory against Churwell WMC to maintain their 100 per cent start to the new season as they moved to the top spot in the Barkston & Ash Leeds Cricket League.

Solid batting from Mohammed Ali Lunat (45), Soyeb Kayat (46) and Yusuf Makda (44) enabled the side to reach a total of 250 runs in their allotted 40 overs.

Supported by excellent all-round fielding and tight bowling they restricted their opponents to 128 runs. Sadik Karolia was the pick of the Mount bowlers, taking four wickets for 38 runs in his 15 over spell.

# Record stand in final

# Mount hat trick of wins

MOUNT CC achieved another outstanding success when their third team completed a unique treble in the Barkston Ash League.

The youngsters, who had already won the Lane Fox and Evening Cups, made sure of their third trophy when they clinched the title with a ten-wicket win over Skelton Woods.

Their success means skipper Yusuf Kayat has become the first captain to collect three trophies in his first season as skipper, something never achieved in the club's 21-year history.

Skelton Woods were shot out for 38, Imran Kayat taking 4-11 and Ismail and Bhamji each taking two wickets. Openers Bhamji (20) and Ismail (21) soon knocked off the runs.

Seedat took 3-11 and S Korolia and S Kayat two wickets each as Azaad were dismissed for 86. Then free-scoring Seedat blasted a quickfire 55 as Mount raced home by seven wickets.

Mount's second string, who are already

champions, had a comfortable win over Phoenix in the Wakefield Union.

A Makda made 81 and E Kayat 34 as Mount reached a healthy 206-9. Then N Lorgat took 4-26 and I Kayat 4-18 as Phoenix were dismissed for 112.

A good weekend was completed when Mount's Dales Council tea, who are also champions, gained a narrow win over Skelton Woods.

M A Aswat hit 34 in the Mount innings of 112 before I Rajah and F Karolia each took four wickets to dismiss Skelton Woods for 110. A notable feature was a wicket in his first-ever over for Amin Loonat, who opened the bowling, having opened the batting in his only other game.

Mount will play the Sunday League play off this weekend at Stanley Falcons.
