## RULES

### Constitution

1. This combination of clubs shall be called the "Bradford and District Evening Cricket League" and shall not be disbanded except by a two thirds majority of the clubs in membership.

### Subscription

2 (a) The Annual Subscription shall be £15.00 payable on or before A.G.M. This fee includes registration of players (any number). Any application for membership to this league shall be accompanied by an entrance fee of £10.00 which shall be returned if the application is unsuccessful.

2 (b) Any club resigning after the A.G.M. shall be responsible for the following season's league fees.

2 (c) Should there be any deficiency at the end of the season each club shall be called upon to pay an equal share.

### Entries

3. All applications for entry to the league shall be considered at a General or League Committee Meeting which shall have the power to admit or reject any club.

### League Committee

4. The Committee to carry out these rules shall consist of two representatives from each club, along with the President and Vice presidents and any member of the executive who is unattached to any club, but so that no one club shall have not more than two votes. Notwithstanding the previous provisions of this rule the Chairman for the time being of any meeting shall have a casting vote. Seven days notice shall be given of Committee meetings and seven clubs shall be present to form a quorum. Any club not represented at a committee meeting shall be fined £5.00.

## Executive Committee

5. This Committee shall consist of President, Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and a minimum of five members, the whole of whom shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting and shall have power to deal with all urgent business.

### The Competition

6. (a) The league shall be divided into divisions as decided by the executive committee. The formation of these divisions shall depend on the number of clubs in membership. The bottom two clubs in each division to be relegated and the top two clubs to be promoted. On any clubs retiring from any Division (except the lowest Division) the following procedure shall be followed.

i) The next highest placed club in the Division below shall be promoted.

ii) The highest placed club of the two relegated clubs from the Division above shall remain in their previous Division.

This procedure to be repeated as necessary. All newly elected clubs to be allocated to the lowest Division.

6. (b) Apart from the lowest Division, all clubs shall play fourteen matches on a home and away basis as arranged by the league secretary. If the lowest Division contains 8 clubs this will also apply. In the event of the lowest Division having other than 8 clubs the League Secretary shall arrange that no club plays no more than 14 or less than 12 matches. No club to have less than six home matches or more than 7 away.

In all Divisions a win shall count 2 points, a draw 1 point and losses ignored. In the event of two or more clubs being level on points, the positions will be decided on most games won. If still equal the positions will be decided on averages. In the lowest Division in the event of clubs not playing an equal number of games, the places will be decided on a percentage basis, i.e. points gained multiplied by 100 and divided by maximum points possible.

### M.C.C. Rules

7. Matches shall be conducted under the M.C.C. Laws of Cricket for one day games, so far as they are not varied by, or inconsistent with, the rules of this league.

### Duration of Matches

8. (a) All matches shall be played on Wednesday evenings except representative and deciding games or re-arranged fixtures. Matches shall commence at 6.45 pm with a maximum interval time of ten minutes between innings. Clubs responsible for late starts shall be fined 25p for every five minutes or part of. Umpires to report offending sides. Should any club fail to put in an appearance by 6.45pm with at least 7 players, they shall be fined £5 and forfeit 2 points and 2 points will be awarded to the non-offending team. Any team failing to fulfil an away fixture shall pay £10 (Ten Pounds) or the cost of hire of the ground, whichever be the greater to the opposing club.

8. (b) Period of play shall be decided by the two opposing captains prior to the toss of the coin. Fifteen overs to be the minimum and 20 overs the maximum (6 ball overs). Failing agreement, the Umpires shall decide. No person shall be allowed to bowl more than five overs in an innings.

8. (c) The Umpires shall decide whether the conditions are favourable for commencing play at the time appointed, ONLY if the Captains cannot agree. After play has commenced the Umpires are the sole judges as to the continuance or resumption on account of weather or light, or any other conditions that may arise.

8. (d) In case of wet weather, unless fifty percent of matches in a Division be commenced, the whole of the fixtures in the Division concerned shall be counted as draws.

8. (e) If a bowler, through injury or illness, be unable to complete an over, that over shall be completed by any other player except the bowler at the opposite end. Individual performances in a rain affected programme shall count towards individual averages.

8. (f) Each club shall provide and bowl a good quality quartered ball and spare. All match and spare balls to be approved by Umpires.

8. (g) Artificial wickets are not to be used for any matches played in the league.

### Alteration of Fixtures

9. (a) In the event of any club having other League or Cup fixtures, interfering with the fixtures home or away of this League, the Executive Committee shall have power to make such arrangements as they deem fit.

9. (b) In exceptional circumstances the full Executive shall have the authority to postpone fixtures at their discretion.

9. (c) ANY CLUB BEING AFFECTED BY RULE 9 (a) OR 9 (b) MUST NOTIFY THEIR OPPONENTS AND THE UMPIRES, ALSO THE LEAGUE SECRETARY, OF SUCH POSTPONEMENT. WHEN THE RE-ARRANGEMENT HAS BEEN MADE IT IS THE DUTY OF THE CLUB HAVING PREVIOUSLY POSTPONED THE MATCH TO NOTIFY THE UMPIRES AND LEAGUE SECRETARY OF THE NEW DATE. THIS DATE MUST NOT BE LATER THAN THE LAST WEDNESDAY IN THE FULL FIXTURE PROGRAMME. ANY CLUB FAILING TO NOTIFY THE LEAGUE SECRETARY OF THE NEW DATE TO BE FINED £5.00.

## Player's Registration and Qualification

10. (a) All players shall be registered with the League Secretary (in writing) and to include the name of the player's Saturday Club by Wednesday a.m. by post before taking part in any match. All such registration to be approved by the Executive Committee. No player shall be registered who has played Test Cricket ~~at any time~~. Also any player who has played First Class Cricket in the current season shall not be eligible. No registration shall be made after the 30th June.

10. (b) Any clubs playing an unregistered or unqualified player shall be fined £10.00 for each offence, and forfeit any points gained from the match to the opposing team, unless the matches are counted as draws, under Rule 8 (d), when the offending team shall forfeit 2 points, but not to the opposing team.

10. (c) A player shall not play for two clubs in this League in one season unless he obtains a transfer to be confirmed by the League Executive Committee. No transfer sanctioned after June 30th.

10. (d) A full list of registered players shall be available in each pavilion and kept up-to-date.

10. (e) A club may register and play only one overseas player. An overseas player is defined as a person not normally resident in the United Kingdom. The name of the overseas player must be identified when registered with the League Secretary.

## Match Reports

11. (a) Each Club shall send a detailed report 'wet or fine' including the fielding point and denoting the wicket-keeper, to reach the League Secretary not later than the first post on the Saturday following the match. Clubs failing to comply with this rule shall be fined £5.00. Also any home club failing to telephone the result after the match shall be fined £5.00.

Also see Special Notice.

11. (b) All Umpires must sign the score-sheets prior to leaving the ground where they are officiating. Failure to sign will be taken as non-attendance and will render the Umpires nominating club to a fine of £12.00. See rule 15. (a).

## Objections

12. (a) Any club desirous of lodging an objection shall do so in writing. Such objection shall be accompanied by a deposit of £5 stating the grounds for objection, and sent by recorded delivery to the League Secretary, to arrive no later than the Monday following the match. An exact copy of the objection shall also be sent by recorded delivery to the Secretary of the Club objected to.

12. (b) If the objection be upheld by the Appeals Committee, the sum deposited shall be returned.

12. (c) Inspection of Club's registered players may be had from League Secretary on payment of £1.00.

## Appeals Committee

13. An appeals committee shall be formed to deal with all questions arising out of Rule 12 (a) and (b). Their decision shall be final and binding on all parties.

## Dress of Players

14. All players are requested to turn out in white. BOWLERS must play in all white.

## Umpires

15. (a) Neutral umpires shall officiate in all matches. Each Club shall be liable to provide one umpire each week, but no Umpire shall officiate in any match in which the club which nominated him be playing. Appointments shall be made by the Executive Committee. Any club failing to send an umpire to a match when ordered to do so, or the Umpire failing to put in an appearance at the proper time, such club shall be fined £12.00 and the competing Clubs may in that case agree upon one of the spectators present officiating. Umpires shall report to the League any fractious

or disorderly conduct on the part of the spectators or players in any match in which they officiate, and clubs shall report to the League any inefficiency or bad conduct on the part of either of the officiating Umpires, such report in either case to reach the League Secretary by the Saturday following the match.

15. (b) All umpires shall wear white coats supplied by the home club.

15. (c) Clubs in all cases shall lodge no less than 1 name with the League Secretary by November A.G.M.

15. (d) All umpires shall be registered with the League Secretary.

15. (e) The Umpires shall be responsible for awarding, where in their opinion it is merited, a fielding point to each side. Any such award shall not include the wicket keeper.

15. (f) If a replacement Umpire is sent by the League Secretary, then the club for whom the replacement is sent shall pay that Umpire £7.50, payable via the League Treasurer 14 days from the date of notification. The League shall be responsible for ensuring that replacement Umpires are paid the due amount at the end of the season.

## Grounds and Appointments

16. All Clubs in this League shall have suitable grounds and dressing accommodation. They shall provide first aid dressings for minor accidents.

The Ground's Sub-Committee shall consist of one representative from each Club along with the Executive Committee and their powers and duties shall be as follows:-

(1). To inspect ground and appointments of all new Clubs before admission to the League.

(2). To inspect at any time, before or during the season, the ground of any Club in the League. Such inspections shall only be made on the authority of the Secretary.

(3). They shall decide whether the ground area and appointments are kept up to the required standard of the League, and have power to make recommendations for improvement which shall be carried out within the period specified.

## Boundaries

17. All boundaries shall be clearly marked and shall count in accordance with M.C.C. Laws.

## Trophies

18. (a) "GUARDIAN TROPHY". This cup will be presented to the Club winning Division 1.

"ARTHUR HUDSON TROPHY". This Cup will be presented to the Club winning Division 2.

"FRANK STOBART TROPHY". This Cup will be presented to the Club winning Division 3.

"TOMMY MONK TROPHY". This Cup will be presented to the Club winning Division 4.

"MIDDLEBROOK CONTRACTORS TROPHY". This Cup will be presented to the Club winning Division 5.

"LES BENSON MEMORIAL TROPHY". Will be presented to the Club winning the knockout competition.

"THE BARLOW CUP". Will be presented to the leading batsman of the whole League.

"WADDELOVE CUP". Will be presented to the leading bowler of the whole League.

"WORTHINGTON TROPHY". Will be presented to the wicket-keeper claiming most victims in the season. In the event of two or more being equal, the one with the most stumpings shall be the winner. If still equal the Executive Committee's decision shall be final.

"L.R. BRIGGS TROPHY". Will be presented to the leading fielder of the whole League.

18. (b) The winners of these trophies shall have possession of them for the period ending 20th July. All trophies shall be insured against loss or damage to their value by the League.

18. (c) The League shall provide 12 medals or prizes of a similar design or character to be awarded to the Club winning each divisional Trophy each year.

18. (d) The leading batsman and bowler from each Division will be presented annually with a prize.

18. (e) Clubs should submit the averages for their leading players (batting, bowling, fielding and wicket-keeping) to the League Secretary within 14 days of the last official fixture, if they wish them to be considered for a trophy.

Qualifications: Batting 8 inns. minimum 200 runs. Bowling 15 wickets. Fielding 3 points. Wicket-keeping 10 victims.

18. (f) The presentation of the trophies to teams and individuals to be made at a function to be arranged at the discretion of the Executive Committee.

18. (g) All trophies and cups shall be returned to the

League Secretary by 21st July. Any Club failing to comply with this rule shall be fined £500. Clubs to be held responsible for individual Trophies for their safe keeping and return of same.

## Fines and Debtors

19. (a) All fines to be paid within 14 days of the date of imposition. Clubs failing to comply with this rule shall be fined £100 for every additional 7 days that the fine remains outstanding.

19. (b) Any debts due to the League shall be paid by October 14th of each year. Failure to comply with this ruling will mean that the offending Club be automatically dismissed from the League.

## Alteration to Rules

20. Any alteration to rules shall be made at a Special General Meeting of the Clubs called for that purpose, or at the Annual General Meeting of the League to be held during November each year, of which 14 days notice shall be given, and with the respective notices calling such meetings the Secretary shall forward to each Club copies of the proposed alterations of Rules. If for a Special General Meeting, Clubs proposing any alterations of rules shall first bring such proposals before the League Committee, who shall sanction the calling of a Special General Meeting, or if for the Annual General Meeting all such proposed alterations shall be lodged with the League Secretary before October 14th.

The Executive Committee shall have power to propose alterations to Rules and call Special General Meetings for this purpose, but shall not have power to vote thereon either as a body or individually except as provided by Rule 4. The powers of voting at General Meetings shall be as stated in Rule 4. Before a proposition shall be put before a General or Committee Meeting it shall be seconded by the representative of some Club other than the one moving the proposition and that any alteration to rule shall only be carried by two thirds of the members present. Any Club not represented at a General Meeting shall be fined £500.

## Questions

21. (a) Should any questions arise not provided for in these rules, it shall be dealt with by the Executive Committee.

21 (b) If any question shall arise in connection with the League Competition, or any Cup, Tournament, or any other Competition organised by the League, whether or not the same is already dealt with elsewhere, either in these Rules or in the Rules of any Cup, Tournament or any other Competition, the Committee shall have full power to inflict such penalties on both Clubs and Players as they shall think fit, and their decision shall be final. By way of example, and not by definition, such penalties may be either a fine, deduction of points, suspension or expulsion from the League, or any combination of them, and the amount of any fine, number of points deducted, or period of suspension shall be at the absolute discretion of the Committee whose decision shall be final, provided that before any such penalty is imposed, the Player and/or the Secretary of the Club against whom any complaint has been made- (i) shall be notified in writing of the complaint being sustained, the Committee may act in reliance of its power as contained in this Rule and, (ii) shall be notified of the date, place and time when the Committee shall consider the complaint, and shall be entitled to attend and listen to all evidence given in support of the complaint, to question any person giving such evidence, to call evidence on their own behalf, and to address the Committee and comment on all points raised.

## Special Notice

Each week the HOME team shall telephone the result of their match in the evening after the match to Mary Storey, between 9.00pm and 10.00pm on (01274) 600491 so as to enable match results to appear in the Press. It is essential that Clubs phone even if the weather has prevented a finish, or even if there is no play.
