

Birkby Civic Youth Club CC

Founded in 1948 and folded in 1965 when it evolved into Birkby Former Members' Association. Between 1948 and 1955 the club had no fixed ground; between 1955 and 1960 they played at Leeds Road Playing Fields; and between 1960 and 1965 Highfields sports arena in Birkby. Joined the Huddersfield Association in 1955.

H.C.T., Lockwood C.Y.C., R.A.F.A., Taxes and West Indians: Leeds Road Playing Fields. No. 40 or 41 trolley bus from the George Hotel.

Almondbury Wesley: No. 18 petrol bus from Lord Street to Kaye Lane, Almondbury.

Birchencliffe: No. 30 trolley bus from St. George's Square to Yew Tree Road, Birchencliffe.

Birkby C.Y.C. and Paddock C.Y.C. O.B.: No. 34 trolley bus from Byram Street to Bradley Bar. The ground is at St. Augustine's School.

Bradley & Colnebridge: No. 40 or 41 trolley bus from George Hotel to Bradley. Ground is down Colnebridge Road.

Moldgreen C.Y.C.: No. 58 petrol bus from Lord Street to Rawthorpe. Ground is at Rawthorpe Secondary Modern School.

Oakes C.Y.C. O.B.: Walk up New North Road from town to Kaye's Central College. The ground, Highfields, is behind this school.

Outlane: No. 73 or 74 trolley bus from Westgate to Laund Road, Salendine Nook. Walk up Laund Road to ground at Lindley Moor.

Police: No. 77 or 78 petrol bus from Upperhead Row Bus Station to Woodfield Park, Lockwood.
