Huddersfield Town Centre

Pavilion

Renovated in the 1970s, the pavilion acts as a base for players and spectators alike, providing a vantage point for those watching the game and a relaxing space for those playing.

Rugby Pitch

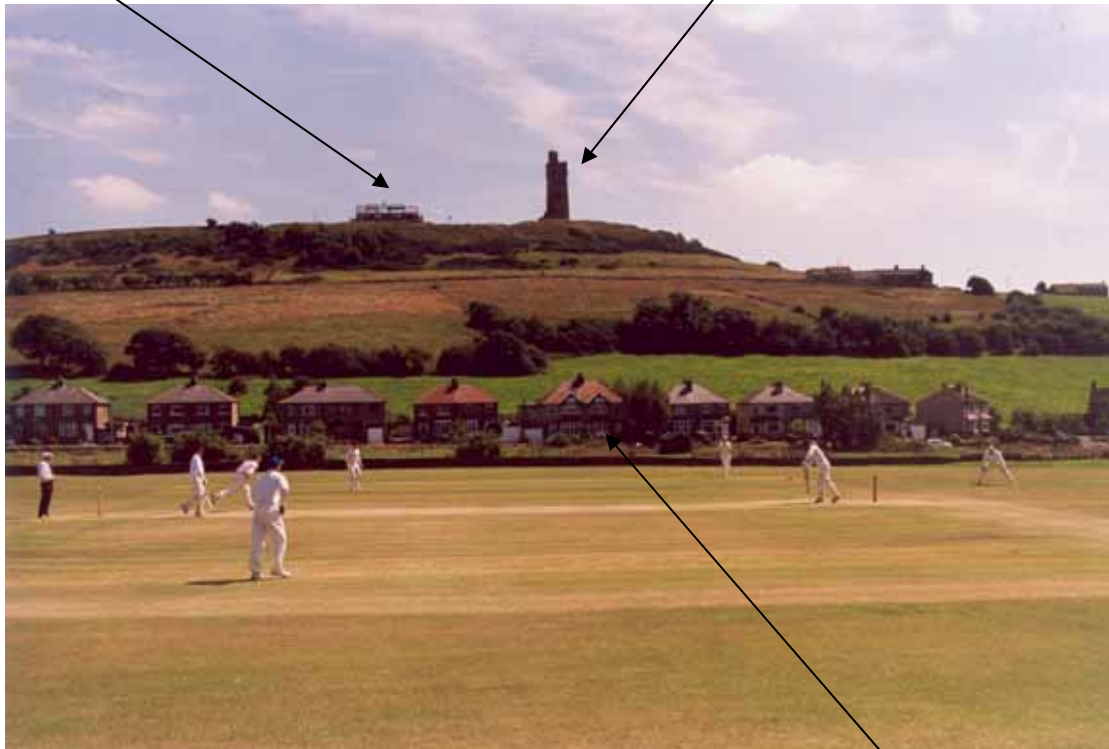
Newsome Panthers play their home games on the adjoining pitches.

Pub

Though this has since been demolished, a pub once stood by the Victoria Tower. After local residents complained about rebuilding plans, the council ordered it to be taken down.

Victoria Tower

This monument overlooks Hall Bower's ground from Castle Hill. Castle Hill is thought to have been settled 4,000 years ago and is considered one of Yorkshire's most important early Iron-Age forts.

**Housing**
