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INTRODUCTION

There is evidence that cricket was played in Wainstalls from 1898, probably as part of local church activities. In later years there was the formation of the local Sunday School League and Wainstalls fielded a team in this. In 1950 E C Calverts, leading local industrialists donated a field to the local community, A community centre was erected and the field transformed into a cricket ground. In 1951 Wainstalls Cricket Club were accepted into the Halifax and District Amateur Cricket Association and ran 2 teams. In 1979 Samuel Websters PLC ceased to play cricket in Halifax and invited Wainstalls to play on their unused ground at the Crossroads. Until 1985 the Club leased the ground on a yearly basis, but following a reorganisation of Websters the Club purchased the ground.
