## INTRODUCTION

Booth Cricket Club was established in 1893. Unfortunately in their first match against Luddenden Foot St Mary's, they were dismissed for 8 runs. By 1900, however, the Team had its first championship success in the Sowerby Division. The Team disbanded during the First World War. In their early years, they were groundless and played at various locations including Tommy Lane and a field behind the Woodman Inn, which was used until 1942 when it was ploughed up. In 1946, permission was granted to construct a ground in the park at Broadfold and the first match was played there on 24 Apr 1948. Booth beat Greetland on that occasion by 4 wickets. In the same season, Booth won the Parish Cup. In the 1980s, the pavilion was refurbished and extended. In 1993 the Club celebrated its centenary.
