## INTRODUCTION

Although the current Club was not formed until 1923, there is evidence of cricket being played in Bradshaw back to 1861 when a team called Bradshaw Golden Fleece played Queenshead United. A Church team called Bradshaw St John's was also active in the 1860s. By the 1890s Bradshaw Mills Cricket Club were playing in the Halifax Parish Cup Competition and had joined the Ovenden and District Cricket League. In 1923 at a meeting at the Bradshaw Tavern, Bradshaw Cricket Club was formed and in the first season the Club won the Collinson Cup.
