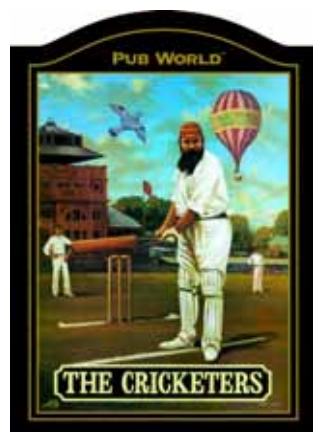


WANTED: INFO ON PUBS & CRICKET!
