The 26 players and wives left the West End pub for the well earned break after a successful season which culminated with a charity match raising more than £200 for the Overgate Hospice.

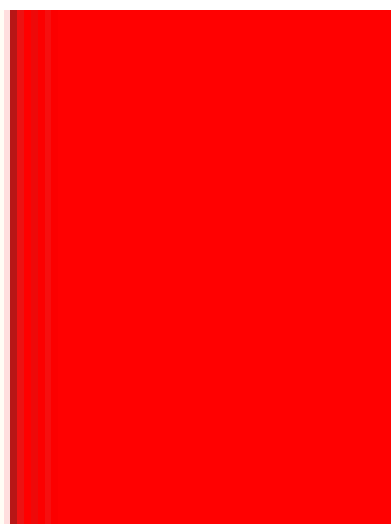


TABLE TOPPERS

West End I, already assured of the Division Two title, finished in style by inflicting a 105 run defeat on Wainstalls II, while in a high scoring game at Eastwood, Wheatley won a thriller by one wicket.

Thomas (79) and Wilkinson (50) were the mainstays for Bridgeholme as they made 197 for seven with Colin Proctor taking four for 30.

A brilliant 103 which included two sixes and 16 fours from opener Dave Hunter still wasn't quite enough to secure the win for Wheatley as they still needed 34 runs when last man Proctor joined Kerskin.

I. Hill caused Wheatley plenty of problems, taking six for 68, and Wheatley certainly began to struggle once Hunter had departed, but Proctor then hit two sixes and three boundaries in his 27 runs which gave them their narrow win.

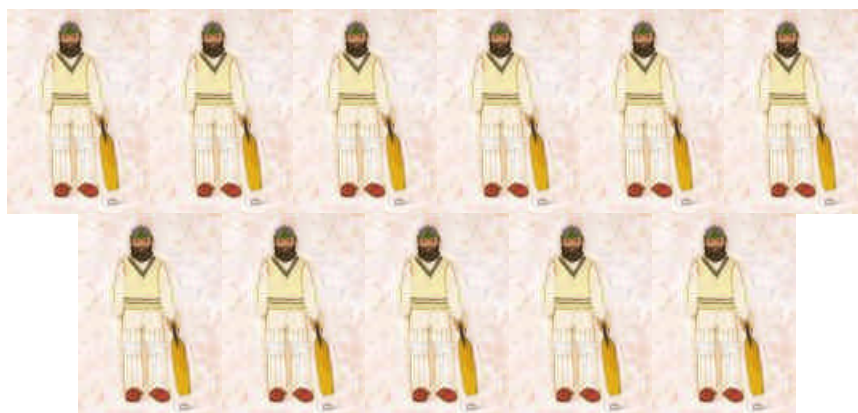

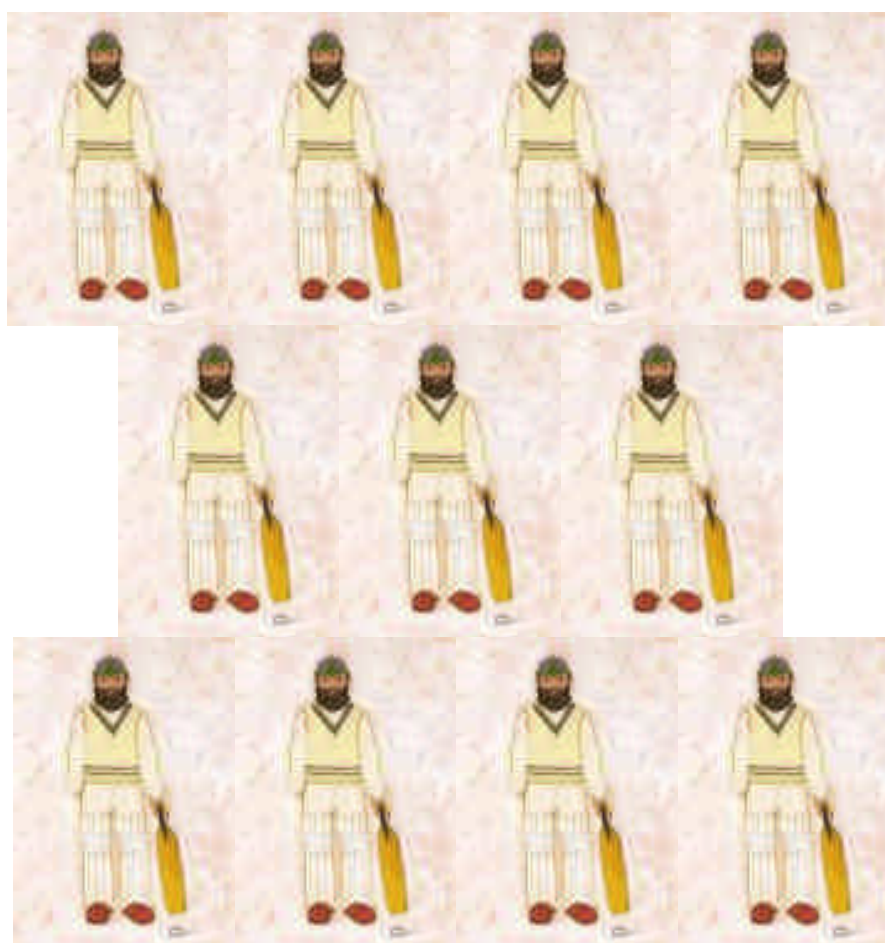
