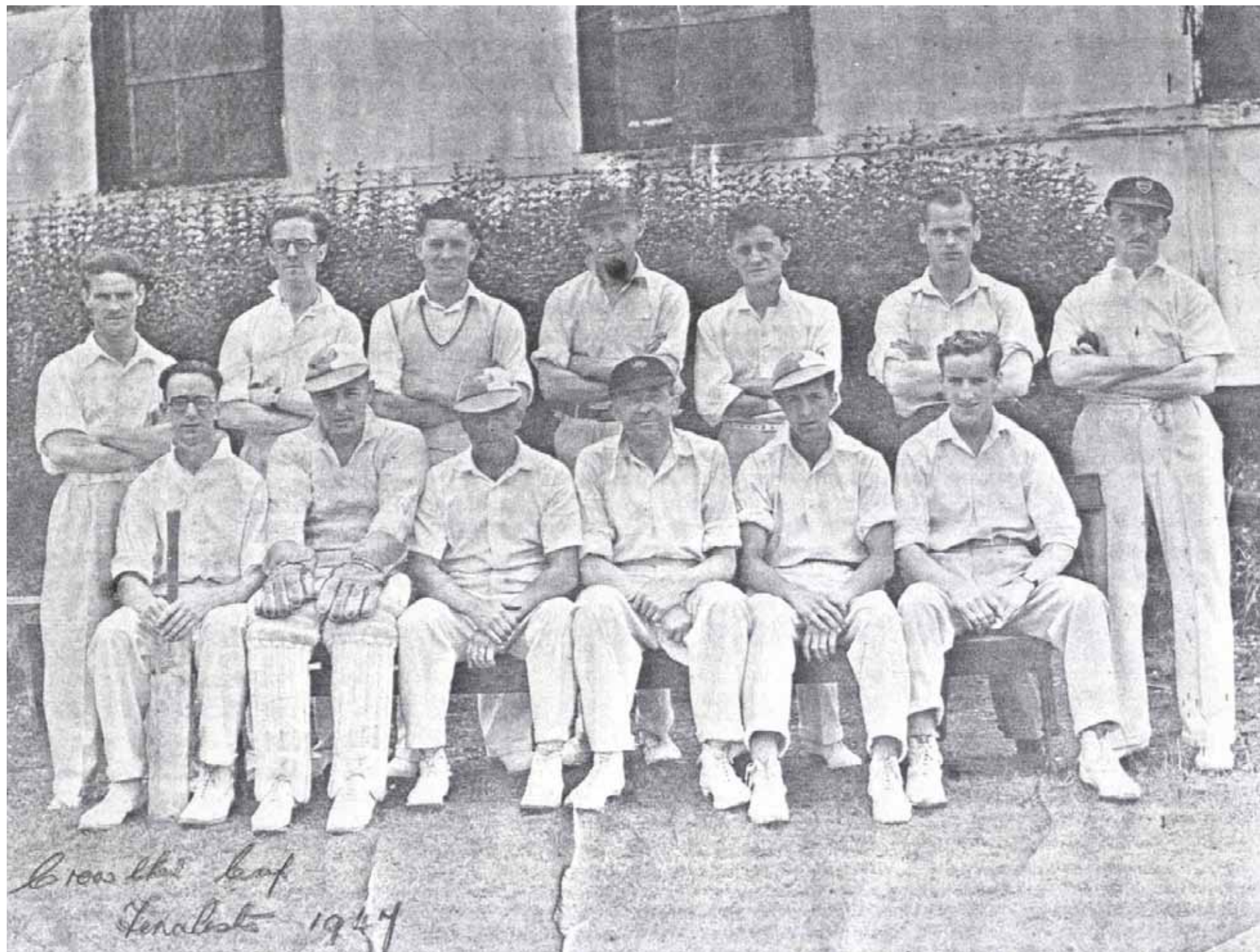
Dear Ladies
