We extend a very warm welcome to Keighley and their supporters. Our visitors, like ourselves, today play the last game of a very disappointing season. They came up into the premier division at the end of last season as runaway champions, surely hoping to make an impact, but their worst fears have been realised and they are already on their way back to the division they left just a year ago. I am sure they can point to the many slices of bad luck that have befallen them during the season. The Moorenders, themselves looking back at a disappointing season, can also look back at the wretched luck that has followed them this year particularly with the weather interrupted games which have always seemed to finish with us "winning on points" but without the points to prove it.

Only Keighley and Morley are currently below us in the table, but while Keighley have already been relegated, Morley can still force us into the lower division as we go into this match with a 17 point lead over them with a maximum 20 points available for a win. Provided that we bowl our overs in the requisite time we need 4 points to retain our 1st Division status.

Unfortunately, our overseas player Khurram Shehzad had to return home some weeks ago due to injury which has hampered us somewhat in recent games, but we arrive at the last match favourites to stay up. Nothing, however, can be taken for granted, and even if we do take the points we need from today's game some personal milestones need to be reached if Cleckheaton want to have any bowlers in the end of season averages. Both skipper John Wood and leg-spinner Tom Pringle's wickets tally currently stand at 29 with a minimum 30 wickets needed to qualify whilst John also needs a good innings to push himself over a 25-plus average. On the batting front, departed Khurram Shehzad has scored 602 runs at 46.31 but a substantial knock from Mark Gill, who has currently scored 544 runs at 45.33, will take him past the overseas man's average. Opener Adam Patel's 577 runs gives him a current average of 30.37 whilst Ian Nicholson's tally of 439 runs shows him averaging of 25.82. Good luck lads, make today's match count.

To our hard suffering spectators, weather permitting, join our players at an end of season barbecue straight after the match, hopefully all will be in a happy mood.
