IT IS AGREED as follows

1. THE player shall attend at the Hanging Heaton Cricket Club or elsewhere

as directed by the Secretary on Saturday in each week for the purpose of playing a series of matches with selected teams during the season of the

year One thousand nine hundred and forty -----

2. THE player shall at all times during the above-mentioned season obey

the directions of and conform in all respects to the arrangements for the

conduct of the team and of the matches made by the Captain or acting Captain

or Committee of the said Club from time to time and shall use his best

endeavours to promote the success of the said club. -----

3. THE player shall during the above season unless prevented by illness

or accident play in such matches as the Captain may require and shall not

play for any other club without the consent of the Captain or Committee and

shall attend at such times and places as the Captain shall appoint for the

purpose of such practice as the Captain may think proper. -----

4. THE player shall not be guilty of any act or conduct calculated to

render him unfit to play in any of the said matches. -----

5. THE club shall pay the player by way of remuneration a sum of

£2. per match plus travelling expenses and the usual club

talents for either batting or bowling and in the case of the match being

postponed on account of rain without a start being made then the Club will

pay the player Half Fee. per match plus travelling expenses and the

said sum shall be paid by the Secretary at such times as he shall arrange.
