

Atkinson's record 'all ten' feat

HARRY ATKINSON, Hanging Heaton's pacesetter, returned career best figures on Saturday by capturing all ten Wakefield wickets. His feat spearheaded the Bennett Lane side to a win that keeps them in front in the Central Yorkshire League title race.

Harry's 10-60, achieved in an unchanged spell of 20.3 overs, bettered his previous best of 9-18 against Hunslet Nelson last year.

It is the first 'all ten' feat in Central Yorkshire League first team play. Previous instances have been achieved in second team matches.

He commenced his memorable haul by bowling Phil Hodson and ended it by doing out the same batsman, David Haigh. In between he was aided by eight small catches by his teammates.

Wakefield made a fight of it thanks to Townsend (44), who produced a dour defence after the College Grove men had slid to 17-5.

Nevertheless, a target of 100 meant no problems for Hanging Heaton. Crowhurst (27) and Jackson (38, not out) finally steered them to victory by eight wickets.

GRAHAM Davies, a former Warwickshire Colly, quickly settled in with Mirfield, picking up a 5-30 haul that stopped championship contenders Liversedge in their tracks.

The odd thing is that Davies, friend of opening bowler Peter Wood, joined Mirfield as a batsman.

It looked odds on a Liversedge victory after they reached 7-3 in reply to Mirfield's 121.9. Doug Lloyd (33) seemed set for another big score, but he was beaten by Tony Atkinson, who could take the credit for causing the start of the Liversedge slump.

Wickets fell at regular intervals to Davies, bowling medium pace off-cutters, and the off-spin of Atkinson (3-39).

Left-arm spinner Roger Bradshaw (3-31) had earlier caused Mirfield problems. Colin Peacock (25) and Alf Hewitt (28), did well after Davies was run out at eight. At one stage Mirfield were 60-3.

After four wickets went for ten runs, Tony Wilson (19) and Clive Brook (19, not out) got together in a useful stand of 30.
