Triumph in Tewitland

WHEN Hanging Heaton Cricket Club clinched the Bradford League championship in September there was cause for a double celebration - this is also the club's 126th anniversary.

As well as the first team's success the second team have had a successful season winning the Bradford League second XI, the Crowther Cup, and coming runners-up in the Priestley Shield.

Of course for the club, winning the championship has almost become second nature, having won the title three times in the last eight years, but it gave supporters and proud members of the club a chance to look back at the history of the Bennett Laners.

The Cricket Club was founded in 1875 and three years later they entered the Heavy Woollen District League.

Up until the Second World War, when Hanging Heaton had already had stints in the Yorkshire Council League and Leeds League, the club had never had much success.

But 1941 saw a new era at the club when Ronnie Robinson joined Hanging Heaton from the East Leeds club. Hanging Heaton became Leeds League Champions and as such played Jack Appleyard's XI in the spectacular wartime match at Roundhay Park.

The match report said that 10,000 people saw the game and Hanging Heaton's Herbert Hainsworth take five wickets for 22 runs.

The club played a number of matches on these fine summer Sundays of the war years against guest teams containing star players who happened to be stationed in the area.

In 1944 Hanging Heaton left the Leeds League to join the second division of the Central Yorkshire League, but a spite in the second division wasn't for Hanging Heaton as they won the league, gained promotion and won the Yorkshire Council Championship.

After more success in the CYL it did not take long for Hanging Heaton to become Central Yorkshire League Champions and win the Yorkshire Council Championship.

From 1973-79 Hanging Heaton finished cham-

ions four times. When they resigned from the CYL to join the Bradford League in 1979 they were undefeated champions.

Through the years they have entertained international cricketers Dilip Vengsarkar, Abdul Qadir and Iqbal Qasbi.

But it is the likes of cricket committee secretary Nat Lawrence, president Rob Mawhitt, secretary Jonathan Reece and treasurer Howard Grey who have put in so much time and effort to ensure that all goes well at the club.

They and a handful of other committee members and supporters work hard, both in the summer and the close season, for the club.

The Cricket Club has always been a strong part of the community in Hanging Heaton and Mr Lawrence is keen to draw attention to the club's links with the two churches, Ebenezer Methodist and St Paul's.

"Our badge incorporates the two churches with references to St Paul's and the Ebenezer Methodist Chapel," said Mr Lawrence.

There is also a bird on the badge to represent Tewit, a variety of bird which was often seen in Hanging Heaton and the reason why the area is so often referred to as Tewitland.

Hanging Heaton was also one of the first clubs in the area to have it's own bar.

"I remember going into the bar with my dad when I was only knee high," recalls Mr Lawrence, but when the bar actually opened is not known.

The bar is a social gathering point for events other than just cricket. There are a lot of members who are separate from the cricketer community and the committee at the club encourages families to attend by putting on special family functions.

"We also have evenings just for the adults as well," said Mr Lawrence.

A full time steward is employed at the clubhouse.

So with a long and successful history behind them, Hanging Heaton are now looking to the future with plenty of confidence.
