The Memorial Ground has a long history...



It is a key landmark on the Huddersfield-Dewsbury main road.



The Memorial Grounds (it should really be *plural* - Moorlands play on the pitch next door) were constructed in the aftermath of the First World. And Mirfield CC moved in following the Second, in 1952.





Lined by a wonderful collection of trees, it is one of the most picturesque cricket venues in Kirklees.



The Pavilion nestles amid more trees and contains bar, changing rooms and a welter of MCC memorabilia inside.



The changing rooms are in the shade and offer waiting batsman a side-on view of the action. The Scorebox is situated at the main-road end of the ground amid even more luscious greenery.
