Spen Lane is considered by many to be one of the most attractive local grounds. With its expansive well-kept grounds, charming clubhouse and easy viewing for spectators, few could argue that this accolade is not well earned.



The clubhouse is situated by the main entrance to the ground, adjacent to the car park and bowling green.

The changing rooms are housed in an old, distinguished construction on the same side of the ground as the clubhouse. The players exit and enter this building several times on matchdays.

Because of its scenic nature, Spen Lane is extremely popular with local cricket-lovers – especially on big-match occasions.















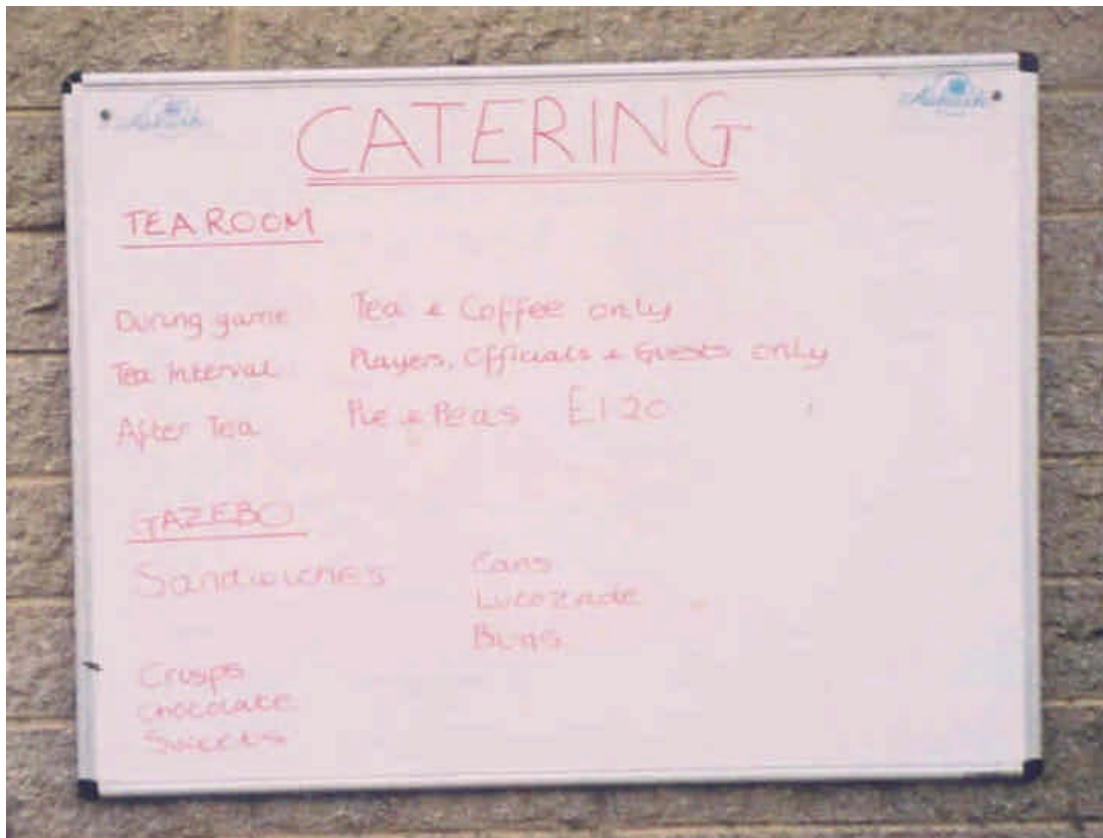




Spen Lane is also home to myriad signs and notices.



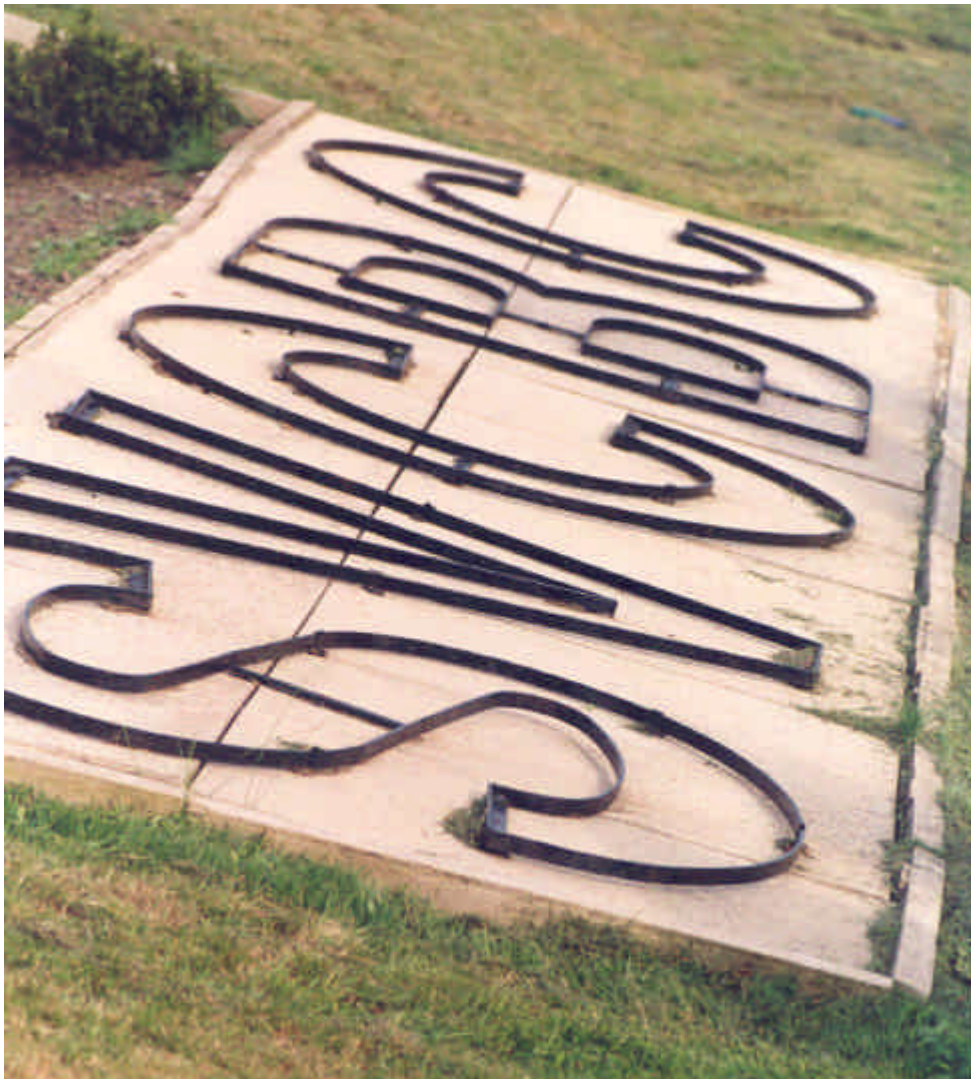






Sponsorship and advertising is extremely important for local cricket clubs like Spen Victoria. As is the sharing of facilities, with other local sports groups.
