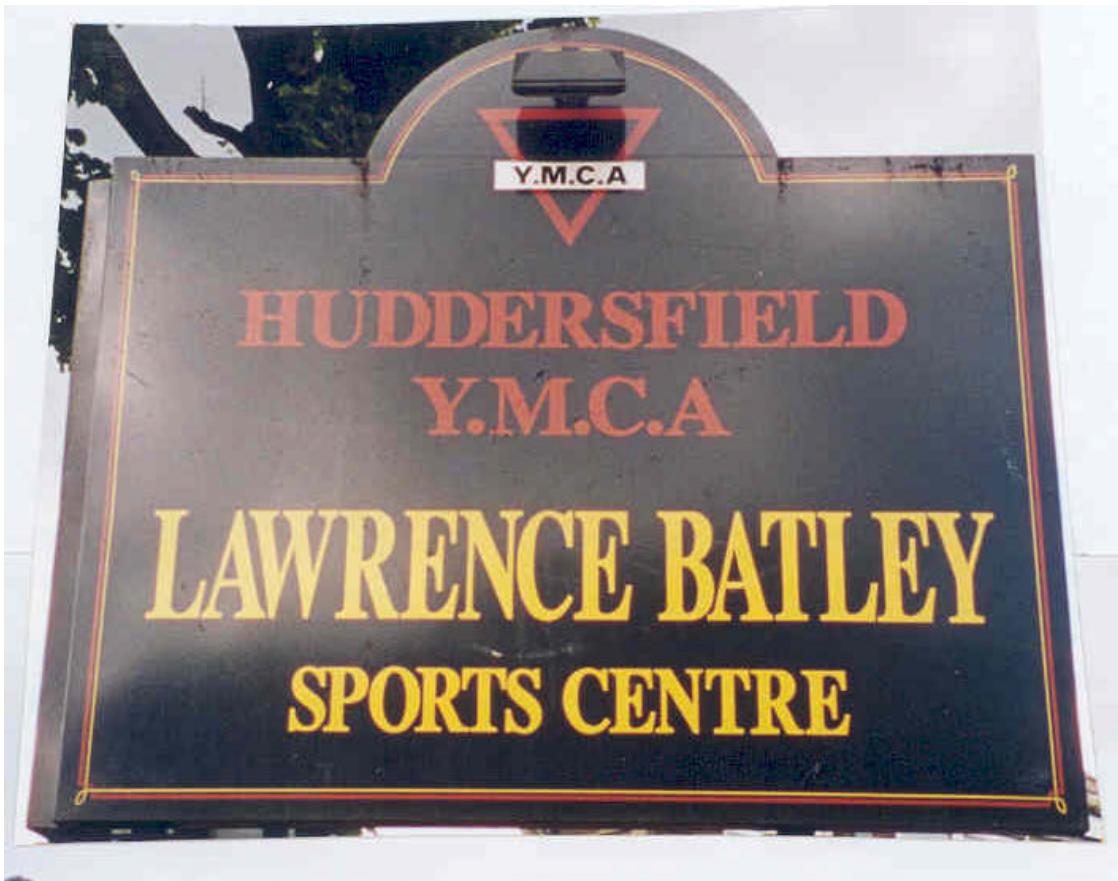


AUGUSTINIANS CC

Augustinians moved to Laund Hill – home of Huddersfield YMCA - in the early 1990s.

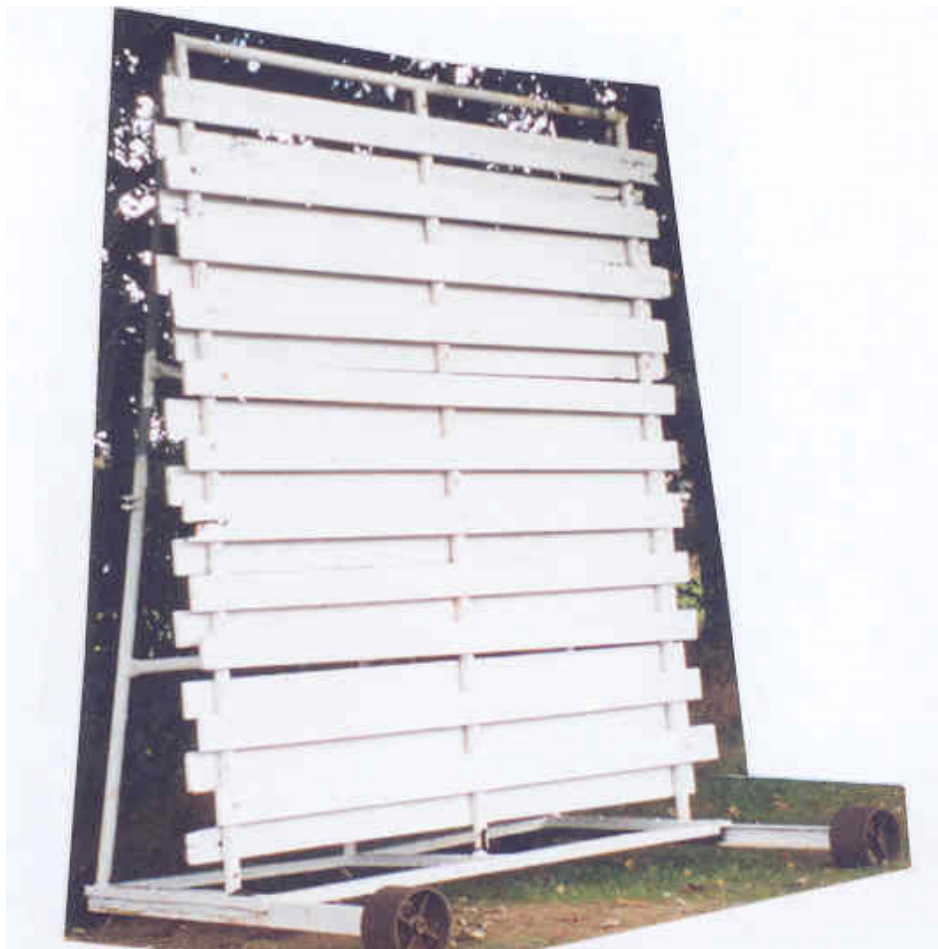
