EVENTS IN PRIMROSE HILL & THE WORLD

Club formed at Cornfield.

1875 Huddersfield Industrial Society opens first shop at Primrose Hill.
Civil Rights Act passed in America.

1876 Stile Common Council School opened. Bell invents telephone.

Move to Cross Lane Allotments, then to present location.

1877 Edison invents phonograph.

1878 Berlin Congress.

1879 New Footbridge built across River Colne. Footsteps up Primrose Hill also constructed – 169 in all! Edison invents electric light bulb.

1880 Mosquito found to carry malaria.

1881 Cambridge Tripos open to women.

1882 Married Women's Property Act.

1883 First Co-op store opens in Primrose Hill. French painter Manet dies.

1884 Greenwich made meridian.

1885 First electric tramcar in Blackpool.

1886 *The Mayor of Casterbridge*.

1887 Queen Victoria's Golden Jubilee.

1888 First box camera. Liberal Club opens at Primrose Hill.

1889 Eiffel Tower built.

1890 London's first Underground.

Win Lumb Cup, beating Dalton by 7 wickets in final.

Join Huddersfield & District League.

Leave District League to join Alliance League.

Win Kenyon Lockwood Cup beating Meltham by 10 wickets in final.

Become one of six founders of Huddersfield Central League.

First winners of Central League Championship. 2nd XI also win their league.

Workshop cricket competitions begin.
