Dave Sutton on chickens and yoghurts

The views out over the Holme Valley from our ground are amazing. In the mid-distance you can just make out the new pavilion at Cartworth Moor Cricket Club, the local chicken farm and Dickinsons on Dunford Road – the people who make the yoghurts. On the horizon beyond you're looking at Penistone and the surrounding area.



We get the extremes of weather up here, but the pitch always plays very well. Graham 'Taffy' Thomas gives me a hand with the roller but I do the cutting. We have two tracks for the Evening League and four for the Saturday team. A score of 300 here is not uncommon.

And it's not a small outfield – around three and a half acres – with sheep and cattle in adjacent fields. There are also some newly-planted trees by the road; these go back to the days when we only had an Evening League side up here.
